COVID 19 Policy For Groomer Operators Effective 12/10/2020

- If a Groomer Operator is sick or has been in contact with anyone who is sick within the last 14 days, he/she shall notify the Groomer Coordinator immediately so modifications can be made to the schedule. No operator shall report to work if they are sick.
- No guests or riders outside of the operator's family unit shall be permitted in the groomer during the
 grooming shift unless it is for official purposes (assisting with grooming operations, landowner, media,
 etc.) If this occurs, all occupants inside the cab must wear a cloth face mask at a minimum.
- At shift change, the outgoing operator shall wipe down all surfaces with disinfectant wipes to be
 provided by the club. These surfaces include, but are not limited to: steering wheel, joystick, toggle
 switches, radio mic, door handles, parking brake, etc. Follow the procedures on the container of the
 wipes.
- The **incoming operator** shall wipe down all surfaces with disinfectant wipes to be provided by the club. These surfaces include, but are not limited to: steering wheel, joystick, toggle switches, radio mic, door handles, parking brake, etc. Follow the procedures on the container of the wipes.
- Operators during shift change should limit contact with each other as much as possible and remain six feet apart when possible. A mask must be worn during shift change when the two operators will be together for longer than 15 minutes.
- Hand sanitizer that is provided by the club should be used before and at the end of shift and after touching any common surfaces (fuel pump, door knobs, etc).
